

PLATEAU EDUCATION FOUNDATION 2026 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

OBJECTIVE

Among the Education Foundation's many goals is the desire to improve educational opportunities for the members of the Cooperative's service area. Since 1993, the Education Foundation has awarded over \$2 million in scholarships and grants. For questions, call 575.389.4387 or 1.800.432.2369 ext. 4387. All applications must be postmarked no later than **February 13, 2026**.

<u>Please ensure you thoroughly review all eligibility requirements. Incomplete applications or missing/incorrect documentation will result in disqualification from consideration.</u>

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS TO APPLY:

- Applicant must be a student with a minimum 2.5 GPA or equivalent on a 4.0 scale. (An authorized school official must verify the GPA on this application.)
- Applicant is planning to attend, or is attending, a regionally accredited vocational school, technical school, or college or university.
- Applicant must maintain consecutive full-time status and maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA.
- Applicant must be a legal dependent¹ of an active Cooperative member², who currently
 receives retail communication services in one of the Cooperative's 26 service exchange
 areas. (Subscriptions to services outside the Cooperative's exchange areas do not qualify.) Legal
 dependents of Plateau employees are eligible to apply for the Tonie Martinez Memorial and
 Committed to Excellence Endowment scholarships.
- A copy of page one of the most recent IRS tax return for the Cooperative member showing the applicant as a legal dependent. Financial information may be redacted for all applications EXCEPT for the Tonie Martinez Memorial and Committed to Excellence Endowment scholarships as these are need-based scholarships.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation must be submitted with the application. The first letter must be from an official of the school you are currently attending. The second letter should be from any other adult who can attest to your qualifications and abilities.
- Each scholarship may have additional, specific requirements.
- Including additional documents such as additional letters of recommendation, resumes, transcripts (when not a specific requirement for the scholarship being applied for), or other attachments will cause the application to be removed from consideration.
- An applicant may only receive funding from one Plateau scholarship at any given time.
- Applicant must submit a recent photo or school photo to be used for publicity purposes.

1 For the purpose of scholarship eligibility, a dependent is an individual that meets the IRS rules as a qualifying child for tax purposes.

2 For the purpose of scholarship eligibility, an active Cooperative member is defined as a person, business, or organization that purchases retail communication services within the Cooperative's service area. Retail communication services purchased in the following areas will qualify as Cooperative memberships - 279 (House), 355 (Fort Sumner), 357 (Grady), 372 (Weber City), 374 (Clayton), 389 (Pleasant Hill), 421 (El Valle), 422 (White Lakes), 423 (Bingham), 427 (Anton Chico), 456 (Bellview), 458 (Ragland), 472 (Santa Rosa), 481 (Farwell, TX), 485 (Roy), 487 (Logan), 575 (East Glen Rio, TX), 576 (San Jon), 584 (Vaughn), 633 (Nara Visa), 641 (Trementina), 673 (Mosquero), 683 (South Clovis), 849 (Corona), 868 (Conchas Dam), or 985 (Ranchvale). Subscriptions to Plateau services outside these areas do not qualify. Retail communication services include landline telephone and/or broadband internet.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTIONS AND SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

Evelyn Patterson Memorial Scholarship - \$8,000 - 3 scholarships Robert M. Harris Memorial Scholarship - \$8,000 - 3 scholarships Larry Wallin Memorial Scholarship - \$8,000 - 3 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- Disbursed over four (4) semesters at \$2,000 per semester.
- An essay must be handwritten in ink pen and submitted with the application. See pages 5 and 6 for instructions.

Banner Scholarship - \$5,000 - 25 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- Disbursed over four (4) semesters at \$1,250 per semester.

Occupational, Trade and Technical Careers Scholarship - \$5,000- 4 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
- Disbursed over two (2) semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a non-baccalaureate or Associate degree program including but not limited to, a skilled trade, technical field, healthcare support, transportation/logistics, or emergency responder.

Vocational Careers Scholarship - \$5,000 - 4 scholarships

- Applicant must have graduated from high school or obtained a GED within the past three (3) years.
- Disbursed over two semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a certificate program including, but not limited to, a skilled trade, technical field, healthcare support, transportation/logistics, or emergency responder.

Tom M. Phelps Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 scholarships

- Applicant must be classified as a full-time college junior or senior at a regionally accredited vocational school, college, or university for the fall 2026 semester.
- Disbursed over two (2) semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- Applicant must include the most recent transcript from the school currently attending.

Frank Blackburn Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a returning college student enrolled at a regionally accredited vocational school, college, or university for the fall 2026 semester.
- Disbursed over two (2) semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an agriculture-related degree plan including, but not limited to, agricultural sciences, agribusiness, animal science, crop and soil science, agricultural engineering, environmental/natural resource management, food sciences, or veterinary-related fields.
- Applicant must include the most recent transcript from the school currently attending.

Committed to Excellence Endowment Scholarship - \$5,000 - 2 scholarships Tonie Martinez Memorial Scholarship - \$5,000 - 2 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a returning college student who has NOT enrolled for at least the past two (2) consecutive semesters.
- Disbursed over two (2) semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- <u>Returning College Students Only</u> must provide a transcript from the last institution attended.
- <u>High School Seniors Only</u> must have scored at least a 22 ACT / 1110 SAT score. An authorized school official must verify the score on this application.

Hal Greig Legal Studies Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 scholarships

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or a returning college student enrolled at a regionally accredited vocational school, college, or university for the fall 2026 semester.
- Disbursed over two (2) semesters at \$2,500 per semester.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a legal studies degree plan including, but not limited to, legal studies, pre-law, criminal justice, political science, public administration, or related fields preparing students for careers in law, public policy, legal research, compliance, or advocacy.
