The Cooperative Board of Directors met in person and by video conference on May 26. Highlights of that meeting follow:

- The Board approved the applications of 58 new members to the Cooperative.

The Affordable Connectivity Program provides a discount up to \$30 per month for broadband service. The Affordable Connectivity Program benefit is non-transferable and is limited to one monthly service discount per household. If the program ends, or if a household becomes ineligible for the benefit, the household will be subject to the regular rates, terms, and conditions of the service.
