Let's go racing!

It's time to get your turtle trained and ready to run! Plateau is proud to sponsor the 22nd annual Great American Turtle Race and Youth Day. The big race is taking place in conjunction with the Curry County Fair at the Curry County Events Center on August 20 at 9:00am MDT. The fastest turtle will win \$300! There are also cash prizes for 2nd thru 4th place. Turtles will need to register prior to race day, August 17 – 19 from 2:00pm – 4:00pm MDT at Plateau, 7111 N. Prince St. in Clovis. Registration will close at 4:00pm MDT on August 19. The race is open to all ages with one turtle entry per person. All turtles must be southwest box turtles and will be returned to the wild at the completion of the race.

Once the determination has been made as to who has the fastest turtle, the fun and games will continue with a sack race, a shoe relay and a stick horse race. Please do not forget to bring your own judge-approved stick horse! These events are open to kids ages 3 to 13. There will be prizes for four

age groups: 3-4 years old, 5-7 years old, 8-10 years old and 11-13 years old.

Temporary tattoos and a coloring station will be there for the kids to show off their creativity! Door-prize drawings will be held throughout the day. You must be present to win.

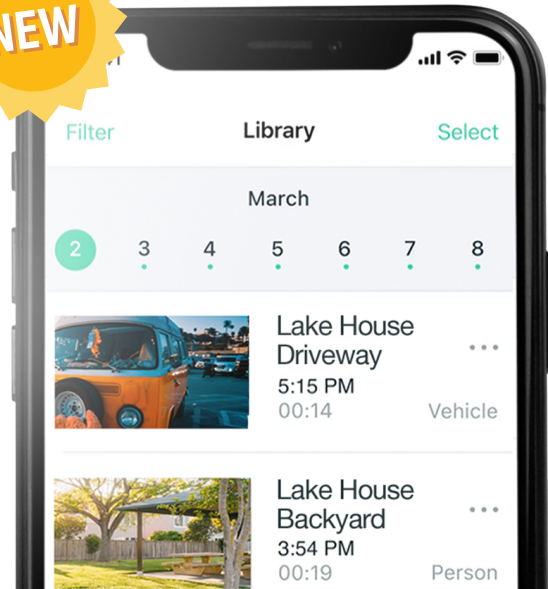
