July Board Meeting Highlights

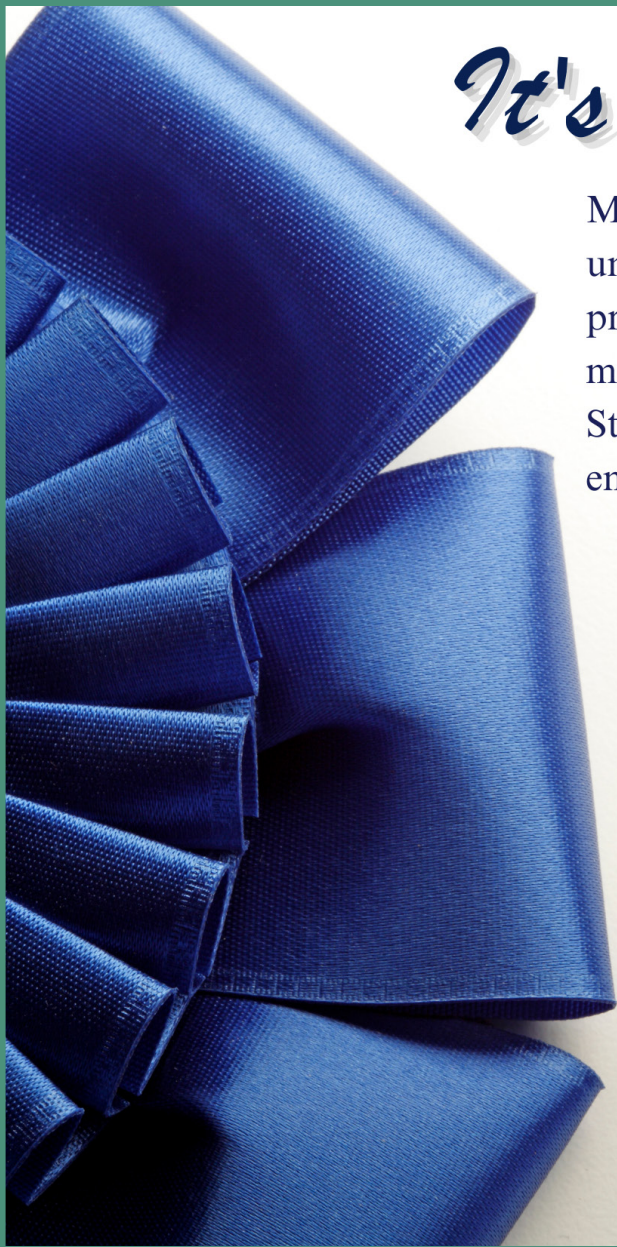
The Cooperative Board of Directors met on July 27. Here are some of the highlights from the meeting:

- The Board approved the applications of 49 new members to the Cooperative.
- The Board approved \$67,821.64 in capital credit estate retirement requests.
- A construction report was presented to the Board:
 - 59 work orders were completed with 15,564 feet of cable placed.
 - Five jobs were completed with numerous projects under construction in Corona, Santa Rosa, Clayton, El Valle and Fort Sumner.

The next regular Board meeting is scheduled for August 24 at the Cooperative's business offices north of Clovis.
